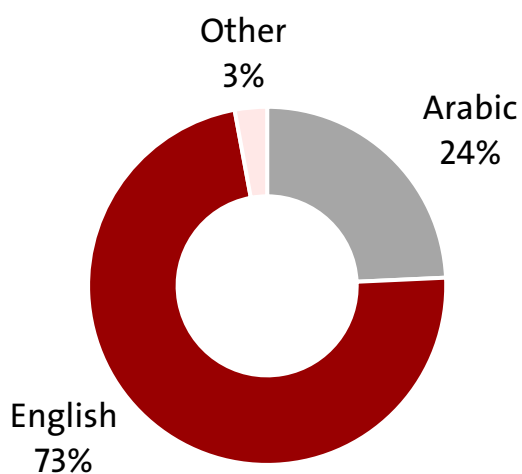

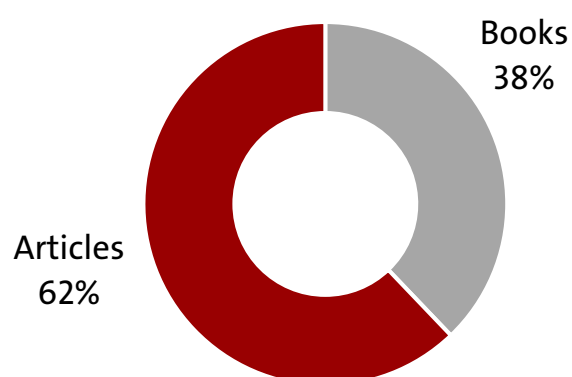

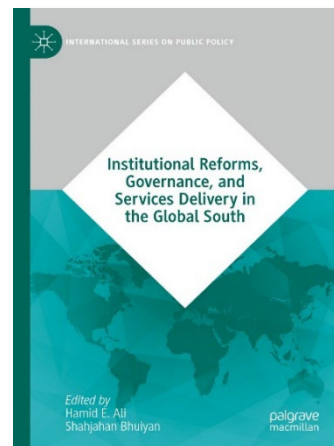
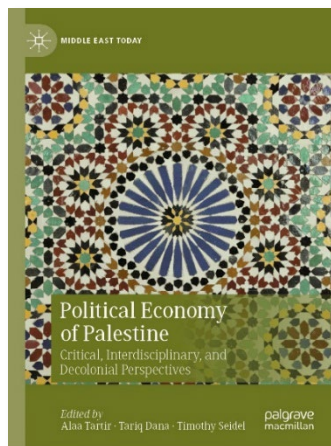
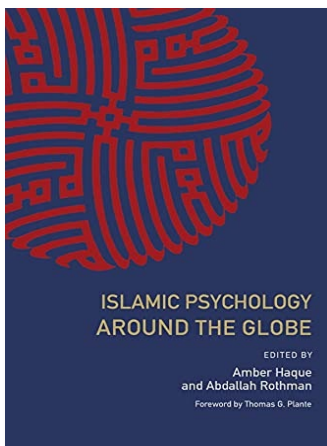
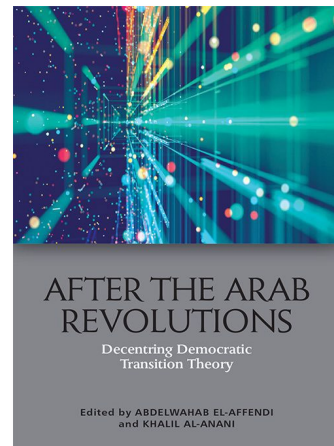
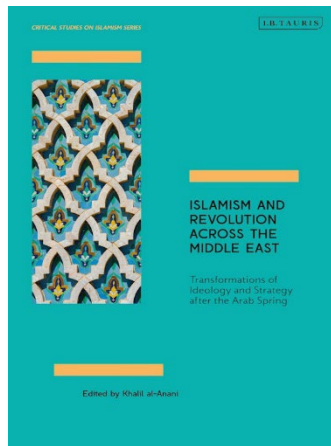
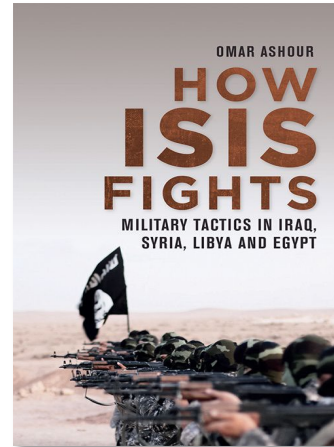
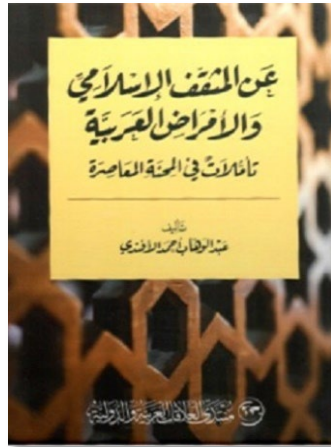


Percentage of Publications per Language
